

Ancient Hellenic Culture Workshop

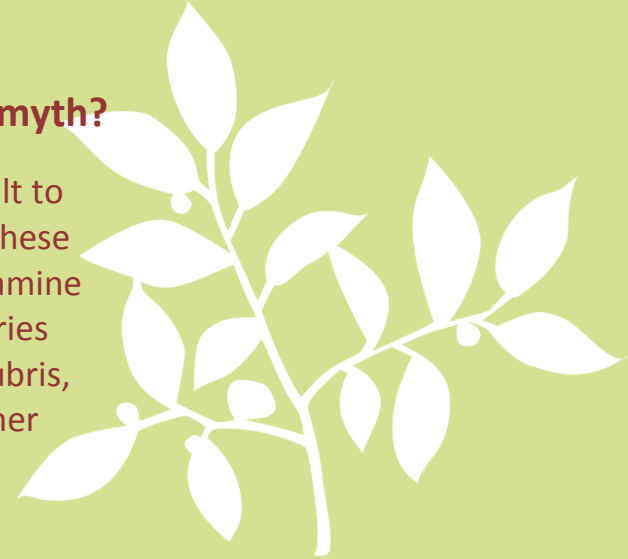
